



SOP FOR CONNECTIVITY MONITORING PORTAL

1. Go To : <https://ctuil.in/> -> Open Access -> Connectivity Monitoring Portal



2. It will lead to LOGIN page. Here, you can login using Application number as ID.




**For now User name will work with Application ID only, Default password is Admin@123 or Admin@1234 , After login change it immediately.

- After login, it will lead to the following page. First, you've to reset your password to change from default. Click on "Change password" to do it.




- After filling all the details, click on “Save Draft”.






9. You can view the filled info by clicking on “View Details”. It will show the filled info as follows.




10. To download status report, click on “Download PDF”.



11. Next, to upload documents, click on “Upload new document” button.




12. Select the document type, and upload it.
