

ADDENDUM TO NOTICE

CERC Committee (Constituted vide CERC's Office Order dated 30.07.2025)

Subject: *Addendum to Notice "Information and Documentation Requirements in respect of Applicants Seeking Extension of SCOD under Regulation 13(2)(h) of the CERC (Sharing of ISTS Charges and Losses) Regulations, 2020"*

In continuation of the Notice uploaded on the website regarding submission of information and documentation for consideration of extension of SCOD, the following clarification is hereby issued for all Renewable Energy Generating Stations (REGS)/Developers:

Addendum – Requirement on Mode of Submission of Documents

Applicants are hereby informed that:

1. Only relevant extracts of documents are to be sent by email

Applicants shall not email full documents.

Instead, they must email **only the relevant pages/extracts** that directly support their submissions, such as:

- Extracts of DPR showing SCOD determination
- Relevant pages of JCC Minutes / CEA reports
- Extracts of Connectivity / GNA grant documents
- Relevant project schedules and progress reports
- Extracts of court orders or administrative instructions relating to delays

This is to ensure efficient review and avoid large email attachments.

Additionally, applicants must adhere to the following requirements regarding email submissions:

- **Only PDF files shall be emailed.** No online document links (Google Drive, SharePoint, WeTransfer, etc.) shall be accepted.
 - If the size of the PDFs is large, applicants shall split the files and send them as **PDF-1, PDF-2, PDF-3, etc., in multiple emails**, ensuring each email stays within permissible attachment limits.
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2. Complete hard copies must be sent to the Committee

While email submissions shall contain only the relevant extracts, applicants are required to submit **complete hard-copy sets of all documents** (including entire DPRs, full correspondence sets, schedules, approvals, and supporting evidence) to the Committee for record and verification.

The hard-copy submissions must be:

- Properly indexed,
- Paginated, and
- Submitted within the timelines prescribed in the original notice.

3. Other conditions of the original notice remain unchanged

All instructions, documentation requirements, and procedures specified in the original notice remain fully applicable.
